Justification:	<p>It is submitted that the admission of MBBS/BDS students have been increased with the passage of time. The present capacity of girls students are is sufficient there are only three hostels for students i.e. Fatima Hall, Liaqat Hall and Jinnah Hall. The hostel capacity of three hostels is 571 and 900 students are residing in their hostels and 329 students are surplus. Their fore a new girl's hostel for 380 students is essentially required. In this regard this office has requested to the Director Architecture Faisalabad and Building Department for Preparation of drawings/ layout plans and rough cost estimate for preparation of PC-1 form. The estimate is still awaited as soon as the estimate received from the building department the PC-1 form will be submitted to the government for approval.</p>

Justification:	<p>It is submitted that at present there is no dental section is available in both divisions in Faisalabad & Sargodha. Importance of teaching and training of BDS Programme and Dental Health Care is essential in public interest. Therefore Dental Block PMC, Faisalabad was established in December, 2008 with the permission of Worthy Chief Minister of Punjab with the yearly admission of 50 students. The honorable Chief Minister Punjab has announced for establishment of Dental Section, PMC, Faisalabad wide Chief Minister Directive No: DS/ems/08/F-55/16663 dated 04-12-2008. The PC-1 form of the scheme along with rough cost estimate was estimated to the Heath Department of approval and inclusion the scheme in 2012-2013 and 2013-2014 but the scheme was not included. Now the estimate has been revised. This office has requested to the Building Department for Preparation of revised estimate. As soon as the estimate received from the building department after vetting. The PC-1 form will be submitted to the government.</p>
