Subject: Grant of No Objection Certificate (NOC)/Accreditation to Faisalabad Medical University (FMU), Faisalabad

The Faisalabad Medical University (FMU), Faisalabad was upgraded from Punjab Medical College (PMC), Faisalabad into a University vide Ordinance Number VI of 2017 by the Provincial Government of the Punjab as a Public Sector University. The University was granted No Objection Certificate (NOC) for admissions in MBBS and BDS programs only in June 2020. The same shall continue subject to the concurrence of Pakistan Medical and Dental Council (PM&DC).

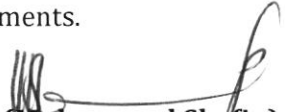
Pursuant to the feasibility report submitted by the University's management, the HEC Accreditation Committee conducted a physical inspection of the Faisalabad Medical University (FMU), Faisalabad on April 11, 2026. Based on the Committee's recommendations, the competent authority is pleased to grant a No Objection Certificate (NOC) to Faisalabad Medical University (FMU), Faisalabad up to **December 31, 2027**, for students intake in the following undergraduate degree programs:-

3. The comprehensive recommendations of the said Committee are attached as **Annex-I** for strict compliance by Faisalabad Medical University (FMU), Faisalabad. This No Objection Certificate (NOC) confirms the institution's eligibility to offer higher education programs under its charter and in accordance with HEC policies and standards. However, this NOC does not exempt the institution from fulfilling any other statutory requirements of the respective government and/or relevant provincial higher education department. The University is expected to ensure full and timely compliance with all such legal and regulatory obligations.

3. Further, HEC reserves the right to withdraw this NOC at any stage if the University fails to satisfactorily demonstrate its ability and commitment to achieve and maintain national academic standards or is found to be non-compliant with HEC policies, criteria, or applicable legal requirements.

(ANNEXURE-I)

Recommendations of HEC for Faisalabad Medical University (FMU), Faisalabad

Specific Recommendations:

- i. The department-wise faculty shall be strengthened through hiring of experienced/well qualified faculty members in all cadres for each department specifically in the departments of Vision Sciences, Renal Dialysis, Respiratory Therapy and Doctor of Physiotherapy (DPT) on priority as per HEC faculty appointment criteria and requirement of relevant professional councils.
- ii. The University shall expedite the approval of its statutes and service structure to enable faculty and staff recruitment. Furthermore, the composition of all statutory bodies must be completed, and meeting of all statutory bodies shall be held as per its Act. The necessary rules and regulations also need to be framed through these statutory bodies viz-a-viz board of studies, board of faculty, Academic council, syndicate and BOGs etc.
- iii. HR files of faculty and admin staff should be properly maintained with all relevant documents as well as having verified terminal degrees from HEC.
- iv. This NOC is granted for the specific place (i.e., **Administration Block, Sargodha Road, Faisalabad Medical University, Faisalabad, Pakistan**) and any change of location will be subject to prior concurrence of HEC.
- v. The University shall register its academic programs in the Pakistan Qualification Register (PQR) in accordance with the applicable requirements.

General Recommendations:

- vi. The University shall develop and implement a comprehensive Faculty Retention Policy, incorporating provisions for career progression, research incentives, and professional development to ensure long-term faculty stability.
- vii. The University shall ensure career progression of all cadres of academic and administrative staff and relevant policies/rules shall be formulated accordingly through statutory bodies of the University. The salary structure of the faculty / administrative staff should be duly approved and notified by the University at par with standard pay package of the government / market competitive.
- viii. The University should formalize MoUs with reputable tertiary care hospitals and clinical institutions to enhance clinical training and hands-on exposure for students enrolled in the Allied Health Sciences Program.
- ix. The University shall upgrade laboratory equipment for Allied Health Sciences programs and establish dedicated laboratories for each academic program within the same premises, in accordance with prescribed standards, to ensure effective practical training.
- x. The University shall convene meetings of the Board of Studies for Medical Laboratory Technology and all other undergraduate programs to finalize and approve the schemes of study.
- xi. The University shall ensure the provision of adequate facilities for students with special needs in accordance with applicable accessibility standards.
- xii. The University shall ensure the timely completion and operationalization of all under-construction academic and support infrastructure in line with the approved master plan, so as to provide adequate facilities for academic and administrative functions and support future academic growth.
- xiii. The University should establish and maintain adequate facilities for female students, including common rooms, designated open spaces, and outdoor sports facilities, to ensure a safe and inclusive campus environment.
- xiv. The University shall ensure the availability of at least 1,500 relevant books per department in the library and subscribe to appropriate digital databases and online academic resources to support teaching, learning, and research activities.
- xv. The University is required to establish separate computer laboratories, each equipped with 40–50 computers, along with the latest hardware and allied facilities, in accordance with the requirements of the respective degree programs.
- xvi. The University shall establish a state-of-the-art laboratory for the MLT program in accordance with the prescribed standards and the requirements of the relevant professional council.
- xvii. The University shall ensure accreditation of its academic programs from the relevant professional accreditation councils.

- xviii. The University shall develop computerized Campus Management System (CMS) including student's registration, attendance, examination, evaluation, fee management, complete teaching mechanism etc. as well
- xix. as other necessary modules as per requirement of relevant programs and functions of the campus.
- xx. All relevant information/record of graduates/enrolled students regarding admission, registration, examinations etc will be maintained properly with all necessary documents in hard and soft form through automation to avoid any problem in retrieval and authenticity of data.
- xxi. The degrees/transcripts of the students shall be printed by the Pakistan Security and Printing Corporation as per template recommended by the HEC.
- xxii. Quality Enhancement Cell (QEC) shall be strengthened with dedicated staff as per HEC criteria. The University must ensure appropriate Quality Assurance mechanism, academic mentoring, examination/assessment mechanism and liaison with the university administration for smooth/effective functioning.
- xxiii. Safety standards must be followed in true letter and spirit. A University level safety policy shall also be devised.
- xxiv. Students support, residential, and transportation services may be ensured for the students.
- xxv. Any new academic department shall be established only after obtaining approval from the University's statutory bodies, respective professional councils and prior concurrence of HEC.
- xxvi. The University shall follow the HEC directives/guidelines for all degree programs, issued from time to time and shall be subjected to periodic monitoring by the HEC.
- xxvii. The University shall submit an evidence-based compliance report at least one month prior to the expiry of this NOC, duly supported by verifiable record.
- xxviii. HEC reserves the right to withdraw this NOC in case it is found that the University is unable to satisfactorily demonstrate its ability and commitment to achieve and maintain academic standards.

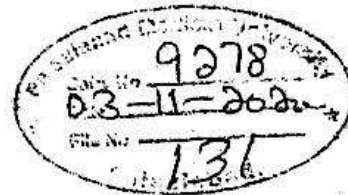

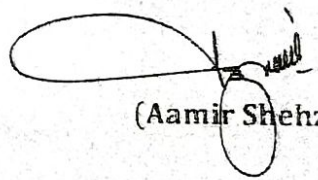
Dear Sir,

I am directed to refer your letter No. 2764/FMU dated 20th May, 2020 on the subject cited above and to state that on the basis of letter of Pakistan Medical Commission (L. No. 92/20-Secy-I/PMC dated 9th January, 2020), the Competent Authority has been pleased to approve the NOC of Faisalabad Medical University, Faisalabad for admissions in MBBS and BDS only. However, the University would be required to ensure the following:

- i. The accreditation and student's registration requirements of a medical university as issued / notified by Pakistan Medical & Dental Council (PM&DC) from time to time must be adhered.
- ii. The number of seats for admission in MBBS & BDS would be as recommended/notified by PM&DC.
- iii. The composition of all statutory bodies must be completed at the earliest and meeting of all statutory bodies shall be held as per act of University. The necessary rules and regulations also need to be framed through these statutory bodies.
- iv. The University would be required to hire regular key positions like Registrar, Treasurer and Controller of Exams. etc. immediately in the light of its Act/Charter's provisions.
- v. No new department shall be established without prior approval of all relevant statutory bodies of the University, accreditation of respective council(s) and prior concurrence of IIEC.
- vi. No MS/MPhil/PhD program shall be launched without obtaining NOC from Quality Assurance Division of IIEC.
- vii. Quality Enhancement Cell (QEC) be strengthened along with its dedicated staff as per IIEC criteria.
- viii. University needs to purchase 1500 books per field and subscribe 15 Impact Factor Journals of at least Impact factor 1.0.
- ix. Necessary academic facilities in all classrooms with appropriate furniture/fixture, lighting, AC/fans shall be made available for the students.
- x. Computer laboratories/workshops shall be strengthened with required latest allied facilities.
- xi. Internet facility with dedicated 50 Mbps shall be made available.

- xii. The University needs to ensure that record of admissions, registration, and examinations of enrolled and graduated students' is properly maintained. In order to ensure proper record maintenance and preservation, the Institute must maintain Students' Admission/Registration Forms in original, Award Lists (semester wise results), Tabulation Register (for scrutiny of award lists), and Gazette Notifications (of graduates) in hard as well as in soft form through automation to determine the authenticity of the university graduate and to avoid any malpractice in the students record.
- xiii. The university will follow HEC directives/guidelines issued time to time for all degree programs.
- xiv. The university will be subjected to periodic monitoring by HEC.
- xv. The university shall submit a compliance report in December, 2020. Before June 2021, the Inspection/Accreditation Committee will again visit to evaluate the University.
- xvi. HEC will review the status in June 2021 to ensure that the above-mentioned requirements or other applicable requirement at that time are met/complied.
- xvii. HEC reserves the right to withdraw this NOC in case it is found that the campus is unable to satisfactorily demonstrate its ability and commitment to achieve and maintain national academic standards.

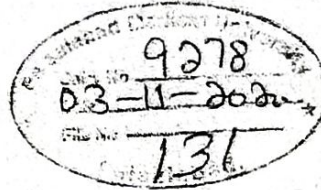
