Anti-Plagiarism Policy

Adapted from the Higher Education Commission (HEC) Pakistan Anti-Plagiarism Policy

1. Purpose

This policy aims to uphold academic integrity, promote originality in scholarly work, and establish procedures for preventing, detecting, and addressing plagiarism in all academic and research activities.

2. Scope

This policy applies to faculty members, students, researchers, administrative staff involved in academic writing, visiting faculty and collaborators. It covers research articles, theses, assignments, project reports, books, conference papers, grant proposals, teaching materials, and all scholarly documents submitted under the institution's name.

3. Definition of Plagiarism

Plagiarism includes direct copying without citation, mosaic plagiarism, paraphrasing without attribution, self-plagiarism, unauthorized AI-generated content presented as original, and fabricated or falsified citations.

4. Similarity Checking

All research documents shall be screened using HEC-recognized plagiarism detection software. Similarity reports shall be interpreted by experts to distinguish legitimate similarity from plagiarism.

5. Responsibilities

Faculty shall ensure originality and educate students. Students shall submit original work and acknowledge sources. The institution shall provide plagiarism detection software, awareness sessions, and fair investigations.

6. Investigation Procedure

Receipt of complaint; preliminary review by QEC; referral to Institutional Plagiarism Committee; written explanation; committee review; recommendation; decision; appeal within 30 days.

7. Conflict of Interest

Committee members shall declare any conflict of interest and recuse themselves where necessary.

8. Penalties

Penalties may include warning, revision, rejection, withdrawal of work, suspension of research privileges, withholding of degree/promotion, disciplinary action, and reporting to HEC where required.

9. Appeals

Appeals may be filed before the University's Appellate Committee within thirty (30) days.

10. Awareness and Capacity Building

Regular training on academic integrity, referencing, responsible AI use, research ethics, and plagiarism prevention.

11. Record Keeping

QEC shall maintain plagiarism reports and proceedings confidentially.

12. Policy Review

Policy shall be reviewed every three years or earlier if HEC revises its regulations.

13. Compliance

All university members shall comply with this policy and latest HEC regulations.

14. Confidentiality

All investigations and records shall remain confidential except as required by law or HEC.

15. Responsible Use of AI

Authors remain responsible for originality and integrity. AI use shall comply with institutional and HEC guidelines.

16. False or Malicious Complaints

Knowingly false allegations may result in disciplinary action.

17. Effective Date

Effective upon approval by the University's competent authority.
